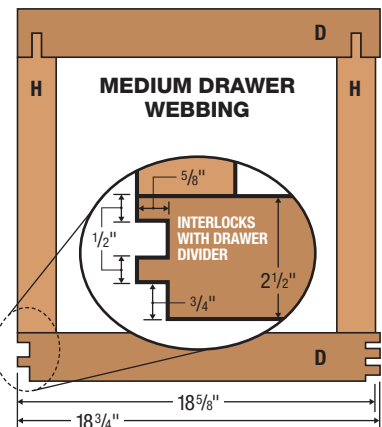
NOTE: The bottom drawer webbing is the same minus the middle thick runner and the drawer divider mortises.



DRAWER DIVIDER



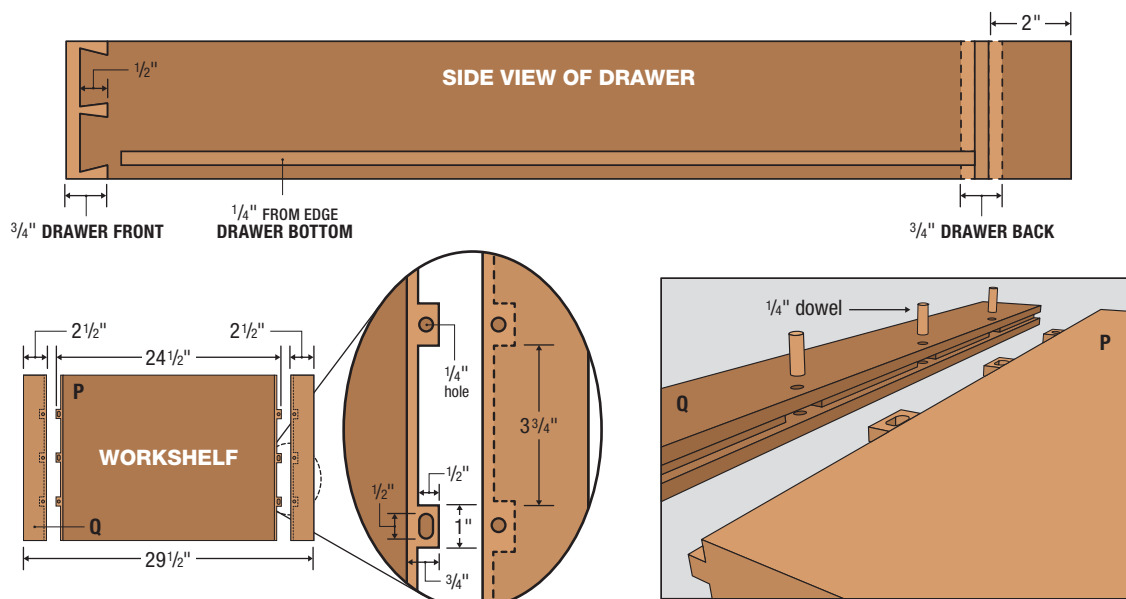
**SMALL

 - Two 1/2" knobs for workshelf
 - Three 5/8" knobs for small drawers
 - Four 3/4" knobs for medium drawers
 - Two 7/8" knobs for large drawers
- Rockler **desktop fasteners** (8pk)
(contains 8 figure-8 fasteners and 16 #6 x 5/8" L flat head screws)
*use to attach case to table top
- **4 screws** (~1 1/4" long)
*countersink through top-most large rail (C) to table top (B)
- Misc. **1/4" dowel** scrap pieces
*use to attach workshelf (P) to bread board ends (Q)

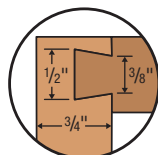
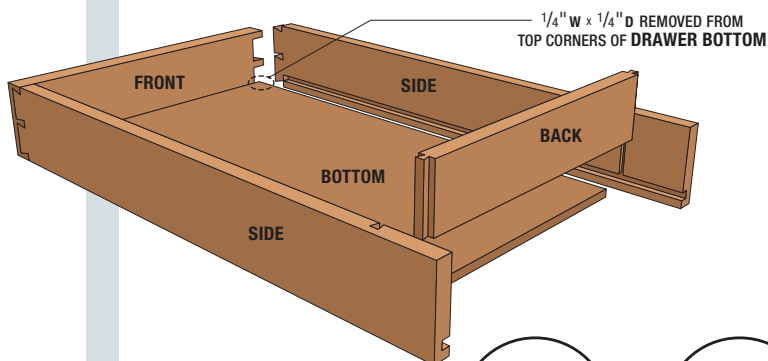

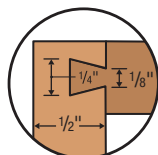

BACK SIDE DOVETAILS

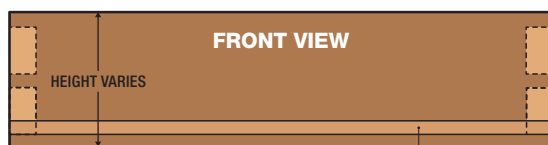

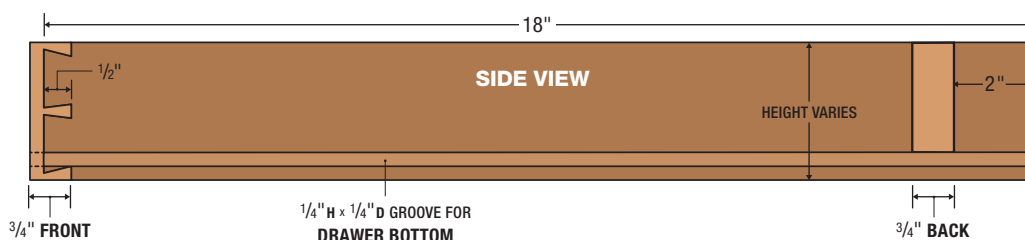
